9:00-12:00	Personal Interviews- Junior Teen and Teen.	Interview suit or dress.	Interviews are panel style and are five minutes each. You will be assigned your interview time at registration. Please report 15 minutes prior to your interview. Be prepared to begin the interview by introducing yourself, with at least your name and contestant number.
	Immediately following the interview you will report to the ballroom to practice your fitness and eveningwear walk. This should take no more than 5-10 minutes, you are then dismissed.	You will stand at a podium for your interview. Jr. Teen contestants will have the option of sitting across from the judges (as we have learned that many are too short to be seen over the podium.)	
After your interview- 1:00	Free time on your own. Dressing rooms will be open.		The ballroom will be open during interviews if you would like to practice on your own.
1:00-2:30	Report to ballroom for final rehearsal. Contestants Only.	Your choice. You may choose to already be dressed in opening number if you wish.	Absolutely no one other than contestants allowed in the ballroom at this time.
2:30-3:30	Dismissed to prepare for pageant.	Winter Wonderland Attire.	Contestants are allowed one person in the dressing room until 3:30.
3:30	Doors open for general admission/general seating.	Tickets are \$15. All parents and guests must purchase a ticket.

*Please bring the following attire for the opening number on Sunday: The theme is Winter Wonderland! White shirt of your choice, bright colored scarf to wear around your neck. Bright colored leggings (can be purchased inexpensively at Wal Mart if you do not have any) or bright colored skinny jeans with winter boots worn with leggings or jeans tucked in. If you have furry or Ugg style boots this is ideal.

*Sundays Pageant will follow this order for competition- Opening number with Jr. Teen and Teen contestants; Junior Teen fitness wear, followed by Teen swimwear; Junior Teen eveningwear, followed by Teen eveningwear. Special performances/ introductions/ farewell presentations- intermission if needed for tabulation purposes. Awards ceremony.

* There will be a top five called in the Teen category. The top five contestants will have an onstage interview with the MC. This will consist of two questions. The purpose of this interview is to allow the judges the opportunity to rank the top five in the situation that there is a tie. If there is no tie between contestants, the interview will not be scored.

* All Jr. Teen and Teen optional awards, special awards, and non-finalist awards will be given during the final awards ceremony during Sunday's pageant. (Non-finalist awards will be given in the Teen division only.)
